- Spokesman of Bar-Ilan University, where he directed the successful rebranding of the institution after the tragic assassination of Prime Minister Rabin.
- Director of the Canada-Israel Committee's office in Israel, where his responsibilities include hosting many Canadian politicians in Israel.
- Public affairs director for the Begin-Sadat Center for Strategic Studies, where he has been an architect of the center's climb to international prominence and distinction.
- Political and diplomatic columnist for *The Jerusalem Post*.

Mr. Weinberg holds degrees in international relations and history from Bar-Ilan University and the University of Toronto. He also studied at the Hebrew University and at Yeshivot Hakotel and Har Etzion. He is married with six children and lives in Nof Ayalon in central Israel.
